Software Development Team

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The software in this suite was developed by an International team of clinicians trained in the use of the BioGraph Infiniti software from Thought Technology that is being used in International Research and





Education Projects. Working in close collaboration with the manufacturers, this team makes sure that the methods used by the Thompson's in clinical practice are implemented in the software to meet the strictest requirements for measurement and help the busy professional get the maximum from their system in the minimum time.

Hardware & Software Configurations (Encoders & Channel Sets)

This Limited Edition suite offers channel sets for both the ProComp Infiniti and the ProComp2 encoders. The powerful ProComp Infiniti encoder gives professionals the power to monitor up to 8 client signals at the same time, ideal for monitoring neurofeedback and biofeedback.

The Infiniti Operating System

The Infiniti program is a neurofeedback and biofeedback operating system like Windows used for doing assessments and feedback. It is used to alter certain aspects of channel sets including band-widths (for the specific needs of an occasional client), dampening (like smoothing or averaging) and % time>C (a threshold constant).

The Infiniti program also does impedance checks and allows you to choose either:

- A Script (series of display screens for a predefined purpose e.g., a stress assessment).
- A 'set' (called "Open Display") your choose 5 display screens for feedback to the client (statistics are only recorded if you check them off before entering training screens). (This may be increased in a later version of the program.)

Suite Software—Display Screens

The self-installing CD includes over 40 specialized screens for clinical assessment, stress profiling and to motivate and train clients. An 84-page guide gives practitioners a basic start so that they can begin using the BioGraph Infiniti[™] program with a range of clients.

- 1. Children or Adults: ADHD (+ Asperger's or + Seizure Disorder); AND, ADD (+ LD)
